Format:	7 rounds Swiss (Sections with 8 or less players will be Round Robin or merged with another group at the discretion of the Chief Arbiter).
Time Controls:	7 rounds - 25 minutes plus 10 seconds increment per move
Tie-Breaks:	 Direct Encounter 2) Buchholz Cut 1 3) Greater Number of Black Wins. FIDE Tiebreak progressive score. Note: If the above is insufficient then they shall be declared Joint Champions
Awards:	Certificates for the Top 3 players and Top Girl in each Section.
Certificate:	Certificate of Participation will be available as a pdf file, please state if you want one when you register for this tournament.
